Cooma's Kristian Sandercoe has won a silver medal at the Special Olympics World games in Austria.

Kristian placed second in the AS Alpine Advanced Super G, with a time of 01:11:81 1 min, 7.92 sec, behind Italian skier Alessandro Dressadore in 01:06:86 1 min, 4.78 sec.

He still had the AS Advanced Super Slalom to contest yesterday

afternoon, but his results were not available at the time of going to press.

Kristian has been skiing for 15 years and was very excited to have won himself a place.

He spent the last year keeping fit and training – swimming during summer and back on the slopes at Perisher in winter.

Kristian, who suffers from

Asbergers Syndrome, also works at Schoos Studios and he has the full support of the Schoos team in his international quest.

His mother, Jan, is with him in Austria.
