- All Special Olympics athlete members, with all skill levels (including beginners, intermediate, and advanced players), can compete.
- All community members, including athletes, officials, and spectators, at Special Olympics events must follow our Code of Conduct <u>found here.</u>
- Athlete event and/or team allocations for all sport competitions will be determined by athlete registrations, previous competition results and/or heats/skill assessments at the event, to ensure athlete divisions are accurate, and fairness is achieved for all athletes involved.

### Athlete Eligibility To compete at the 2024 Victorian State Games, athletes must:

- 1. Be a registered 2024 Special Olympics Australia member in their chosen sport/s or be from a registered Special Olympics Australia Affiliate Program. Please note that affiliate members who wish to qualify for the 2026 Special Olympics National Games must be Special Olympics Australia registered before competing. - 2. Abide by the qualification requirements outlined below:

must be 8 years of age on the first day of competition. Also:

- Have competed in a minimum of 2 club or regional events prior to the state competition to obtain accurate entry information.
- Regularly trained with a qualified coach in the lead up to the event.
- Current and accurate Scores/Times/Distances are recorded and are submitted by the coach prior to competition.
